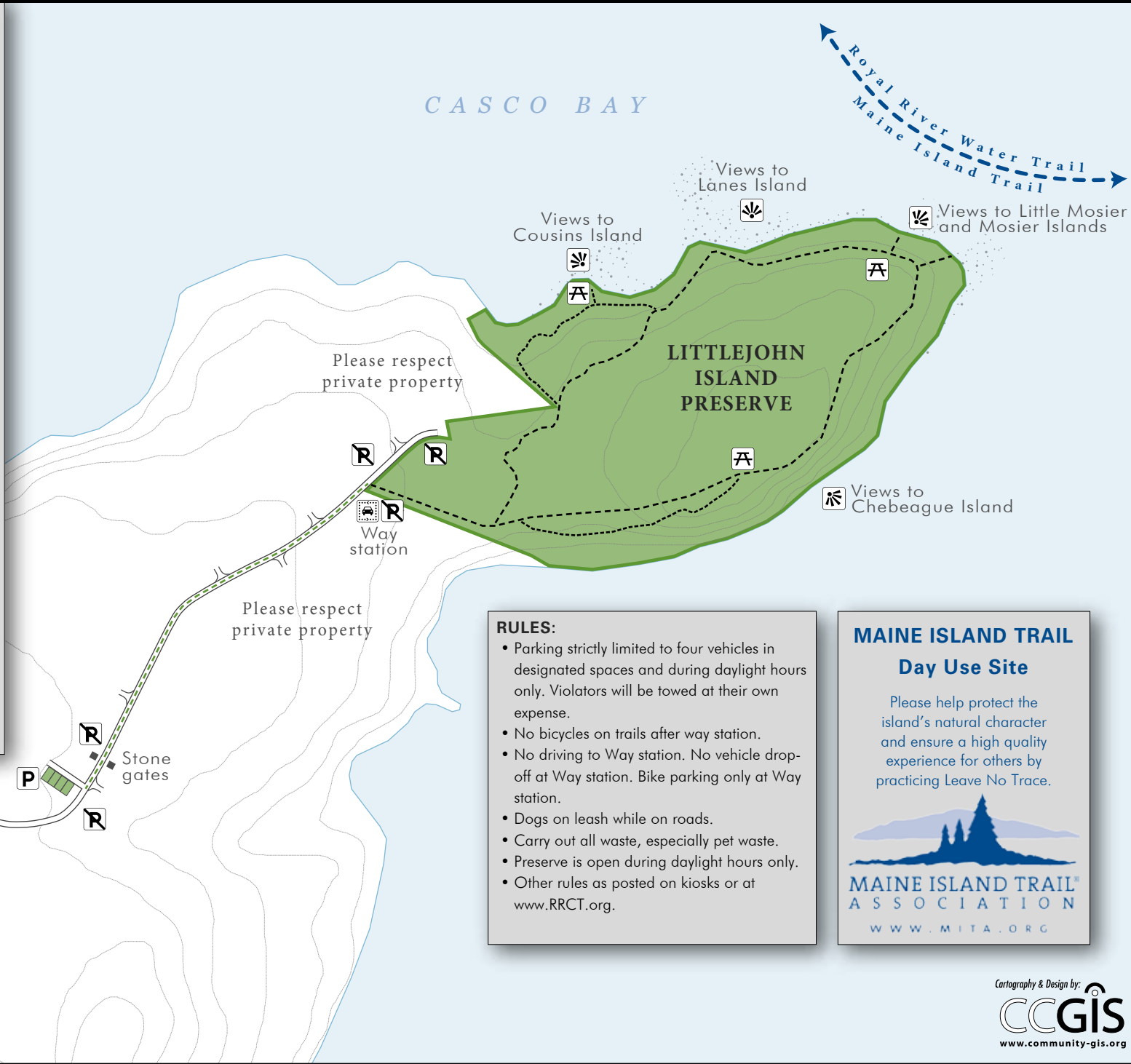
KEY TO FEATURES

Parking strictly limited to four vehicles in designated spaces and during daylight hours only. Violators will be towed at their own expense.

 -  Trail - flatter, more accessible sections (1.3 miles round-trip from parking)
 -  Trail - scenic, rugged sections
 -  Trail along road
