GETTING THERE: Heading northeast on I-295, take Exit 22 in Freeport/Durham. Turn right onto Route 136 north and drive 6.2 miles. Turn left onto Rabbit Road and continue onto Runaround Pond Road for 1.1 miles. Look for the entrance to the parking area and boat launch on the right.
